- U.S. citizen, U.S. National, permanent U.S. resident, or citizen of one of three U.S. Compact Nations (FSM, RMI, ROP).
- Admitted to a relevant program at the University of Guam.
- Suitable mentor who is a University of Guam faculty member with experience in cancer research or relevant field.
- Research or career interest related to cancer health disparities in the Pacific
- Students of Pacific Island ancestry and/or students with significant experience in the Pacific region will be granted priority

BENEFITS

- \$3,000 per semester up to 2 years (pending availability of funding)
- \$6,000 per semester to work as a Research Assistant
- \$500 stipend per semester
- Faculty Mentorship
- Research Experience and Training
